Associate graduate faculty status allows individuals who are not a part of the regular graduate faculty at UNI to teach graduate-level courses. It is reserved for unusual circumstances where the following conditions are met: (1) there are no regular graduate faculty in the department available to teach such courses; (2) courses require specialized expertise which the non-graduate faculty member can provide. ***Appointment to Associate Membership is for a specified period of time, up to an academic year (fall and spring semesters).***
