The Lubker Award was created and is supported by the academic deans to honor Dr. Jim Lubker, Professor of Communication Sciences and Disorders (1995 - 2009), Dean of the College of Humanities and Fine Arts (1995 - 2005), and Interim Executive Vice President and Provost (2005 - 2009). This award is an annual cash prize recognizing a UNI faculty member for "excellence in research and scholarship". Faculty are limited to receiving the award every ten years. The major selection criterion is exceptional original contributions to research and scholarship, including the creative and performing arts.

Nominees must be a tenured member of the University of Northern Iowa faculty with at least five years of full-time service at UNI at the time of nomination. One nomination from each department may be submitted by the department head to the dean by Friday, October 14, 2022.

The department head will include the CV of the nominated faculty member along with the nomination. *After consulting with the College Senate, the dean will forward up to two names from COE; CSBS, CBA_and four names possible from CHAS to the Graduate College by Friday, November 4, 2022 by 4.30 PM.* In addition, each college dean must attest to the fact that the appropriate College Senate was directly involved in selecting the nominees. The deans' nominees will be contacted by the Graduate College and asked to submit supporting materials, which are due by *Friday, January 27, 2023 by 4.30 PM*.
